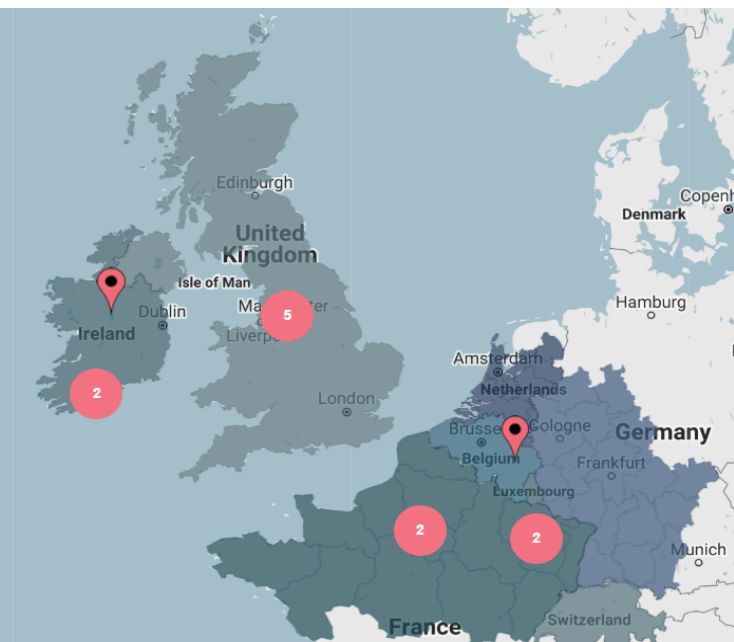


RED WoLF Project Partners

The Project is led by Leeds Beckett University, UK. RED WoLF project team comprises 13 partners from 4 European countries (UK, France, Ireland, and Belgium).

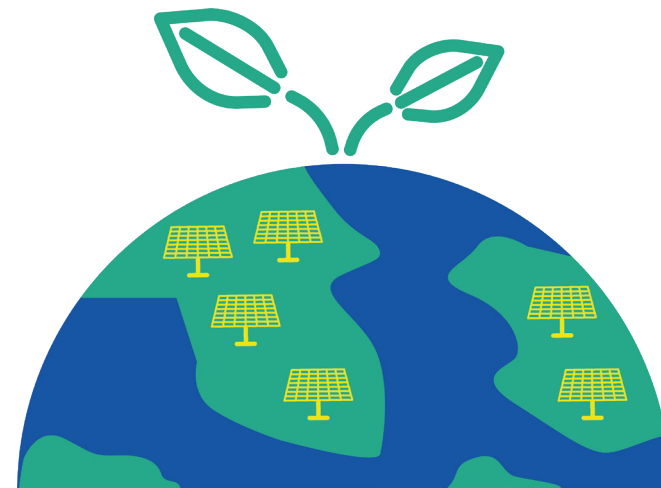
