

tackle common challenges in the area.



SeRaMCo's contribution to the Programme



- Development and testing of new concrete mixes and technologies for the production of concrete precast products (CPPs)
- Materials tested at 3 sites in Wallonia (BE),
 Saarland (DE) and Moselle (FR).
- Delivering cement and CPPs made from up to 100% recycled aggregates and ready for commercialisation in NWE







Varied themes contributing to the EU and Global Strategy

- **Sewage/waste water** (e.g. nutrient recovery, production of recycling-derived fertilisers for farmers)
- **Green construction** (e.g. sediment reuse for erosion and flood protection, secondary raw materials for cement and concrete production)
- New technologies to recycle textile
- Reduce food waste in the first part of the food chain
- Recycling of Critical Raw Materials from Data Centres
