# Accelerated Evaluation

 If you test plan requires a start date before or soon after the call deadline, it is possible to request early evaluation.








#### **FORESEA Support Package**



**Definition:** Free access to a FORESEA Test Site for up to one year





#### **FORESEA Support Package**



#### Tailored for your technology and chosen test site



Test facilities and services dependent on your technology requirements



State Aid rules and thresholds must be considered



60% funding from Interreg NWE

Match-funding to be confirmed with each test site



#### **Application procedure**



- ✓ Contact access coordinator for general information and guidance on selecting a test site if required
- ✓ Familiarisation with the preferred test site and preliminary discussion in regards to a support package for testing and validation
- ✓ Fill out application form
- ✓ The completed and signed application form should be sent to calls@foreseaproject.eu
- ✓ Signed original to be posted to the access coordinator
- ✓ The User Selection Board will evaluate application
- ✓ If successful, support package will be awarded move to access contract



#### **Feasibility**





Can the test site provide the facilities and services you need?

Is the test feasible?

#### **Schedule**



- What is the timeline for your testing (from build completion to transportation, deployment and decommissioning)?
- How can that be supported by the test site?

## **Co-Financing**





Co-financing can come from your existing operational costs for testing.

- What is your budget for test costs out with the berth fee?
- How will that be financed (public or private funds)?

**USB feedback on this criterion**: The financial plan is <u>mandatory</u>; information on the sources of match-funding is required to assess state-aid compliance; information on whether the necessary funds are secured, or when they are expected to be, is also useful.
