














(Regional GDP, Theil index)

Priority 3 – 18 projects with the same aim

Our projects lead to an optimised use of material resources and a reduction in the use of natural resources in NWE

The expected result relates to the main target group, **the resource intensive industrial sectors.**

Boost the transition of the NWE economy to a **circular model** (3Rs - Reduce, Reuse, Recycle)

Demonstration and pilot test projects: maximise the transfer of knowledge and expertise between stakeholders.



A variety of themes

- **Green construction** (e.g. sediment reuse for erosion and flood protection, secondary raw materials for cement and concrete production)
- **Sewage/waste water** (e.g. nutrient recovery, production of recycling-derived fertilisers for farmers)
- New technologies to recycle textile
- **Reduce food waste** in the first part of the food chain
- Recycling of Critical Raw Materials from Data Centre Industry



RAWFILL's expected contribution to the Programme

- Enhanced Inventory Framework & DST are implemented by 25 LF owners/managers in the NWE regions
- LF Geophysics method has been demonstrated on 2 sites (Belgium and France)
- At least 175 tons of materials are recovered
- 175 enterprises supported
