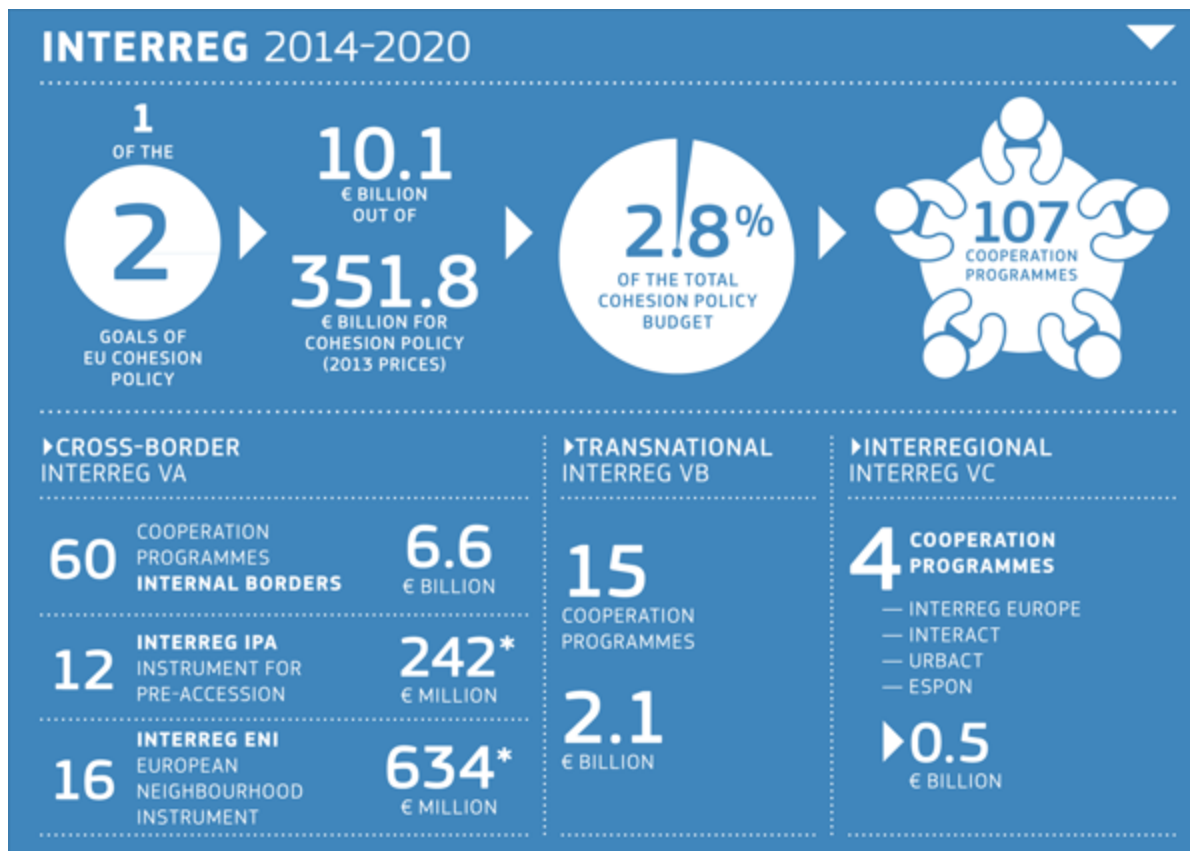

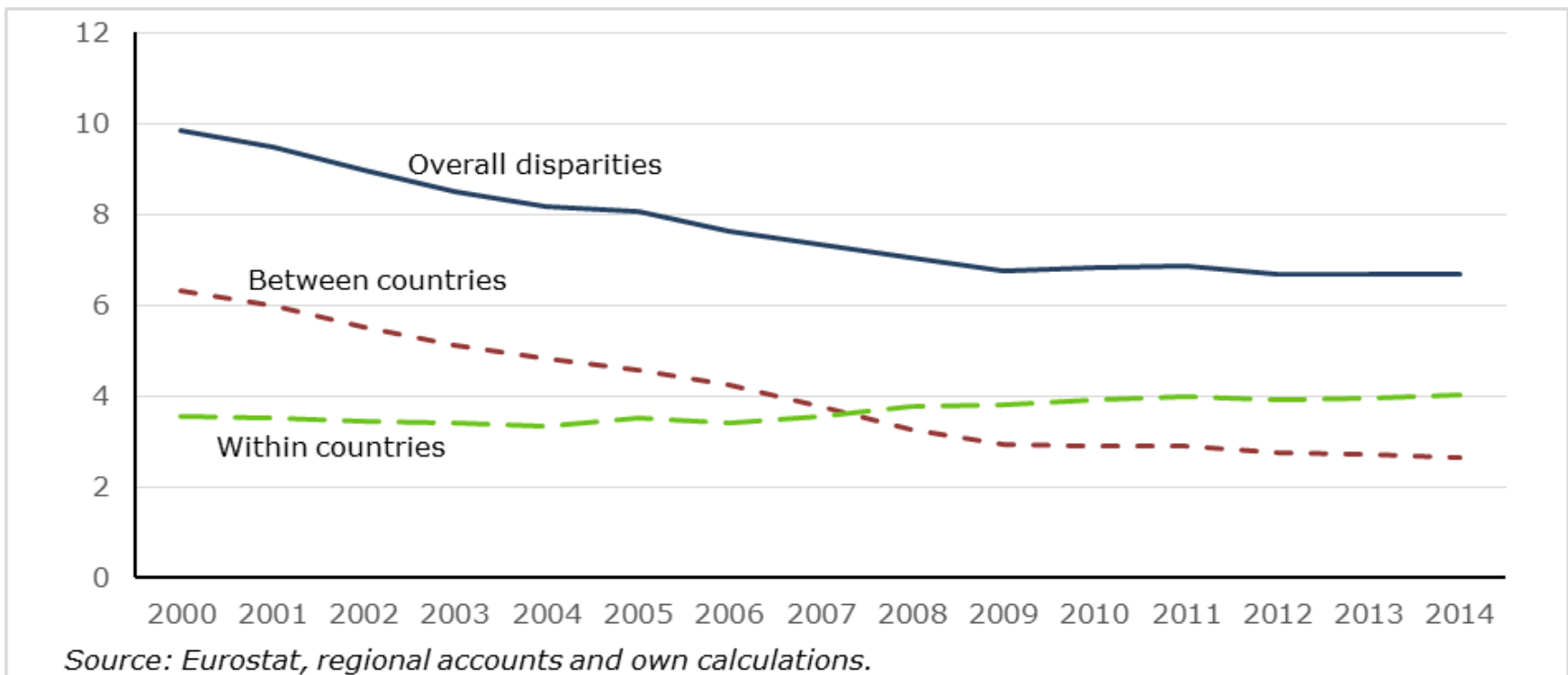




EC 2007-2014 evaluation

 - Decisions 25-26 September 2019 (REGENERATIS)

- Call 9, only **Innovation and Circular Economy**
 - Project Idea Lab: Brussels 2 April
 - Step 1 closes 14 June 2019
 - Step 2 deadline 6 February 2020

Priority 3 – 18 projects with the same aim

Our projects lead to an **optimised use** of material resources and a **reduction in the use** of natural resources in NWE

The expected result relates to the main target group, **the resource intensive industrial sectors.**

Boost the transition of the NWE economy to a **circular model** (3Rs - Reduce, Reuse, Recycle)

Demonstration and pilot test projects: maximise the transfer of knowledge and expertise between stakeholders.

A variety of themes

- **Green construction** (e.g. sediment reuse for erosion and flood protection, secondary raw materials for cement and concrete production)
- **Sewage/waste water** (e.g. nutrient recovery, production of recycling-derived fertilisers for farmers)
- New technologies to **recycle textile**
- **Reduce food waste** in the first part of the food chain
- Recycling of **Critical Raw Materials** from Data Centre Industry

RAWFILL's expected contribution to the Programme

- Enhanced Inventory Framework & DST are implemented by **25 LF owners/managers** in the NWE regions
- LF Geophysics method has been demonstrated on 2 sites (Belgium and France)
- At least **175 tons of materials are recovered**
- **175 enterprises** supported
