Lawful basis for processing data:

Data Protection law says that we must have a legal ground to process your information. These are known as lawful grounds. The Water Test Network partners will each process data in performance of a task carried out in Legitimate Interest for the purposes specified below.

For Small and Medium Enterprises (SME) to access this support offered by the Water Test Network, they will need to submit 2 application forms. These application forms will assess their eligibility and suitability to the project. The application forms will capture basic business contact details (company address, company phone, company email). This data will be used to facilitate the communication between the SME and the Water Test Network project.

Information provided by SMEs through the application forms will be shared among project partners. This is necessary to enable the application review process to take place. To provide the best service possible, information provided on the application forms may also be shared with the preferred test facilities or supporting agencies.

Data controller:

All the organisations listed above are joint or common controllers.

How long do we keep your data:

We are required by the INTERREG programme to keep information for three years after the PROGRAMME has ended (not the project). The programme ends on the 31 December 2023, which means that the Water Test Network will need to keep the information until 31 December 2026.

Security:

We have put in place appropriate security measures to prevent your information from being accidentally lost, used or accessed in an unauthorised way, altered or disclosed. Where we use third party providers we have ensured that they too have such appropriate security measures. In addition, our employees, agents, secondees and suppliers will only process information on our instructions and in accordance with this privacy notice.
