We're proud to say we've had a really great year. CHA bought 7 houses - thereby saving the residents from eviction - and secured 33 more, which will become part of the housing association in the next few months.

We have also created an Energy Masterplan and secured part-funding from Europe to install PV panels, storage and smart meters in 22 of our houses. Within the next year, we are planning to create our own Better Energy Communities project for the Skibbereen area.
