SITE VISITS - NWE IMPACT ON THE GROUND

Your chance to see live what some NWE projects have achieved, in a wide variety of domains.

- <u>E=0</u>: Desirable, warm, affordable homes thanks to energy retrofitting (Hem, FR)
 - Visit one of ten renovated houses provided with net zero energy level, meet its tenants and exchange with the project managers on the benefits of holistic retrofits and low-carbon buildings.
- SHICC: Community Land Trusts: a solution to the housing crisis (Lille, FR)

 Discuss how the social impact of CLTs is measured with elected representatives from

 Lille (FR) and Ghent (BE) before going to a construction site and see for yourself CLTs'

 contribution to more cohesive cities.
- <u>HeatNet</u>: Achieving energy neutrality with district heating (Kortrijk, BE) With elected representatives from the city of Kortrijk and the urban designer in charge, find out about the transition strategies the city has put in place to deliver low carbon district heat. Visit to the local district heating and cooling network.
- <u>CEDaCI</u>: Developing circular economy in the data centre industry (Quesnoy-sur-Deûle, FR)
 - With R&D engineers, explore how strategic metals from waste are identified, extracted and recycled, and examine how circular economy can apply to data centres.
- RIVER: Green chemistry: from CO2 to cosmetic gel (Lille, FR)

 Discover how CO2 can be transformed into high-value products in the Lille Catholic

 University laboratory and exchange with experts on the key role of carbon capture in relation to emission reduction.
- <u>EYES</u>: Empowering youth through employment and entrepreneurship (Wattrelos, FR)
 - Hear from several NWE projects working on youth employment and entrepreneurship in a community centre and discuss the different social innovation approaches to these topics.
