### **SHICC: Community Land Trusts: a solution to the housing crisis** (Lille, FR)

Go to a construction site and see for yourself CLTs' contribution to more cohesive cities before discussing how the social impact of CLTs is measured with elected representatives from Lille (FR) and Ghent (BE).

With elected representatives from the city of Kortrijk and the urban designer in charge, find out about the transition strategies the city has put in place to deliver low carbon district heat. Visit to the local district heating and cooling network.

**CEDaCI: Developing circular economy in the data centre industry** (Quesnoy-sur-Deûle, FR)

With R&D engineers, explore how strategic metals from waste are identified, extracted and recycled, and examine how circular economy can apply to data centres.
